

VILLAGE OF TUXFORD

BYLAW NO. 1-92

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EMERGENCY PLANNING ACT, 1989 .

The Council of the Village of Tuxford in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council shall establish an emergency measures organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur, in accordance with the Emergency Planning Act .
2. The Organization shall consist of two branches;
  - (a) The Executive Committee which shall consist of 3 members appointed by resolution of council. This committee shall establish policy for the Emergency Measures Organization and appoint a Co-ordinator of the organization.
  - (b) The Planning Committee shall consist of officers of the Municipality of Tuxford and such other persons as deemed necessary. The Planning Committee under the chairmanship of the co-ordinator shall formulate a municipal emergency plan.
3. The Municipality of Tuxford shall provide funding as the Council deems necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Measures Organization .
4. The Council may co-operate with Councils of other Municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization, and may for this purpose enter into an appropriate agreement, as provided in Section 5 of this Bylaw .
5. The Village of Tuxford may enter into any agreement with the Province of Saskatchewan or other governmental agency as authorized by the Emergency Planning Act or regulations thereunder .
