

BYLAW No. 3-90

VILLAGE OF TUXFORD

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF TUXFORD IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
TO REQUIRE THE CONNECTION OF PROPERTY TO THE SEWER AND WATER SYSTEM .


THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TUXFORD IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the owner of property, whether occupied or not, in the Village of Tuxford, shall upon the written request of the said Village, connect this property to the Municipal sewer and water system.
- (2) The connections made shall be approved by and done under the supervision of Council.
- (3) Paragraph (1) of this Bylaw shall apply only to property owners whose land lies adjacent to a street or lane along which sewer and/or water mains have been laid.
- (4) Failure of an owner of property to comply with paragraph (1) upon the request of Council, the Council may cause the required connection to be made and the cost of making the connection shall be added to and form part of the taxes on the land on which the connection was made .
