

VILLAGE OF TUXFORD

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF WASTE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF
TUXFORD .

The Council of the Village of Tuxford, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Solid household wastes are to be deposited in the garbage bins provided by the Contractors who has been hired by the Village, waste deposited therein shall be:
 - (a) Normal household garbage only and such shall be in closed garbage bags .
 - (b) any cardboard boxes deposited shall be flattened prior to deposit in the bin .
2. Garbage being accumulated and stored for the purpose of being deposited in garbage bins or privately hauled away to a waste disposal ground, shall be kept in covered fly proof, water tight containers, securely fastened to prevent it from being ravaged by animals.
3. No person who is not a resident of the Village of Tuxford shall ^{not} deposit any matter or thing in the Village provided garbage bins .
4. All garbage other than normal household garbage, is to be disposed of by the owner of same, by hauling such to a waste disposal ground .
5. No person shall dump, deposit, or allow to be deposited in any manner, garbage of any type, on Village streets or any Village owned property.
6. A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary of conviction to a fine of \$50. for the 1st offence, and \$200. for each subsequent offence .
