

VILLAGE OF TUXFORD

A BYLAW TO REGULATE CONTRACTORS & BUSINESSES

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TUXFORD IN THE PROVINCE OF SAKATCHEWAN,  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person, contractor, organization or company shall carry on business within the village unless a valid licence is obtained, issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw .
2. No person, contractor, organization or company shall carry on work within the village which requires a development permit, prior to obtaining such permit.
3. Subject to the right of the council to suspend or revoke the same, as provided by the Urban Municipality Act, every licence issued hereunder shall remain in force and effect until and including the thirty-first day of December of the year issued .
4. Every licence issued hereunder shall specifically state the kinds of services which the licensee is authorized to offer and shall be in Form "A" as attached to this Bylaw .
5. Every person licensed under this bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Clerk, any member of village council, licence inspector or any peace officer, produce such licence for inspection purposes .
6. The fee payable for a licence under this bylaw shall be  
Twenty           dollars .
7. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty as outlined in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Tuxford .
